Program Name: BSW Research Orientation Programme (2019-20)

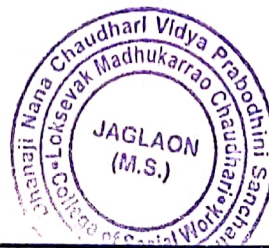
