### Program Details:

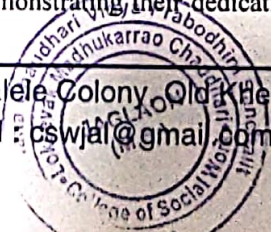


